In June 2007, Pope Benedict XVI announced a special year dedicated to Saint Paul. The Year of Saint Paul will run from June 28, 2008, to June 29, 2009. This Jubilee Year will mark the approximate 2,000th anniversary of Saint Paul's birth. Pope Benedict XVI also announced that the Pauline Year will be ecumenical in a special way, reflecting Saint Paul's commitment to the unity and harmony of all Christians. In this way, the Church will be reminded of her need to be witnesses to the Gospel message.

With this web site, we invite you to also be a witness to the Gospel message by remembering Saint Paul. Here, we offer activities for students in the primary grades to junior high, a workshop for families, biographical information about Saint Paul, a prayer service and articles to assist in your reflection. Correlation Faith First, Legacy Parish

Grade 3

- Chapter 8, page 71, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle taught that we are temples of the Holy Spirit.
- Chapter 9, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle.
- Chapter 10, page 88, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle taught that the Church is the Body of Christ.
- Chapter 25, page 219, has a short biography about Saint Paul the Apostle and quotes 1 Corinthians 12:3.

Grade 4

- Chapter 8, page 71, has a short biography of Saint Paul the Apostle.

Grade 5

- Chapter 6, page 55, mentions that Saint Luke was a companion of Saint Paul the Apostle.
- Chapter 9, page 79, quotes 1 Corinthians 12:4-6, Saint Paul the Apostle teaches that there are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- Chapter 9, page 81, explains Saint Paul the Apostle's teaching of the fruits of the Holy Spirit as written in Galatians 5:22-23.
- Chapter 10, page 86, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle taught that the Church is the Body of Christ.
- Chapter 15, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle and the people of Corinth.
- Chapter 25, page 218, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle teaches us to pray without ceasing in his letter to the Thessalonians.

Grade 6

- Chapter 6, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle and his letter to the Ephesians.
- Chapter 7, page 63, explains that Saint Timothy was baptized and traveled with Saint Paul

the Apostle.

- Chapter 8, page 71, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle taught that the Holy Spirit dwells within every baptized person.
- Chapter 18, page 155, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle and Barnabas were named Apostles after the Resurrection and Ascension.
- Chapter 23, page 200, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle teaches that Jesus is the wisdom of God.
- Chapter 25, page 218, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle advises us to pray at dusk, dawn, and noon, in his letter to the Thessalonians.

Mystery of God

- Chapter 1, page 14, quotes Saint Paul the Apostle, 1 Corinthians 13:12, explaining that God is always a mystery.
- Chapter 10, page 104, quotes 1 Corinthians 15:3-6, Saint Paul the Apostle telling about the Resurrection.
- Chapter 12, page 128, mentions Saint Paul the Apostle's teaching that we are temples of the Holy Spirit.

Morality

- Chapter 1, page 12, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle taught that the best way to holiness was not to great things for God, but to do loving things.
- Chapter 3, page 30, quotes Romans 6:11, 14-15, 23, Saint Paul the Apostle's teaching about sin and grace.
- Chapter 4, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle's letter to the people in Corinth.
- Chapter 7, page 75, quotes Saint Paul the Apostle's letter to the Romans, Romans 13:10.

Church and Sacraments

- Chapter 1, pages 11-12, Saint Paul the Apostles teaches that our spiritual gifts are for building up the Church and the greatest spiritual gift is love.
- Chapter 2, page 21, explains Saint Paul the Apostle's teaching that the Church is the Body of Christ and the Temple of the Holy Spirit.
- Chapter 3, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle.

Jesus in the New Testament

- Chapter 1, page 13, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle boldly preached the good news.
- Chapter 3, page 31, mentions that Saint Mark the Evangelist was a companion of Saint Paul the Apostle.
- Chapter 6, page 65, explains that Saint Paul the Apostle used symbolic language in his letters.
- Chapter 7, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle's letter to the Romans.
- Chapter 8, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle's letter to the Philippians.
- Chapter 9, the entire chapter is about Saint Paul the Apostle's letter to the Colossians.
- Chapter 11, page 114, mentions that Saint Timothy was a companion of Saint Paul the Apostle.

Church History

- Chapter 1, page 11, mentions that Saint Paul the Apostle became an Apostle after the Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus.
- Chapter 2, pages 20-21, explain Saint Paul the Apostle's mission to the Gentiles.
