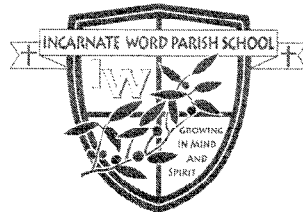
Job Search Assistance & Career Networking

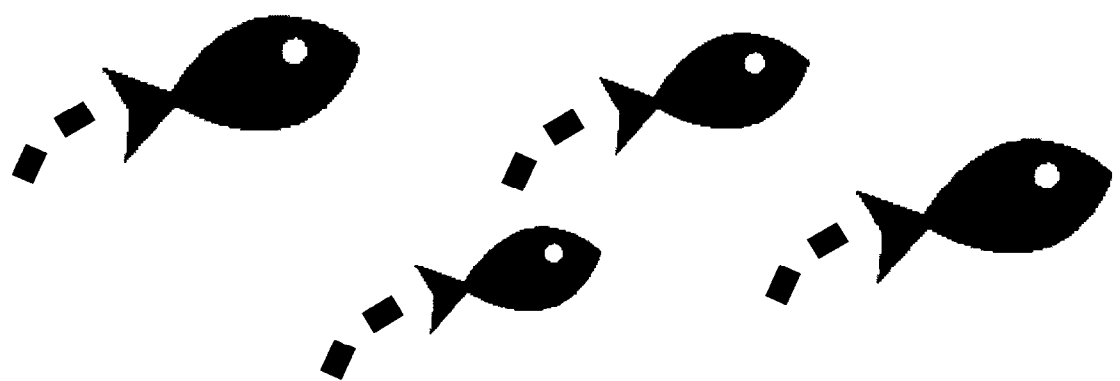

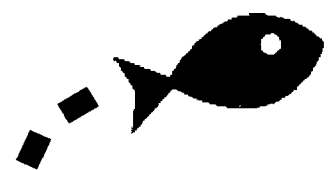
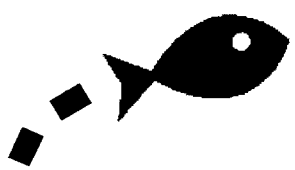
