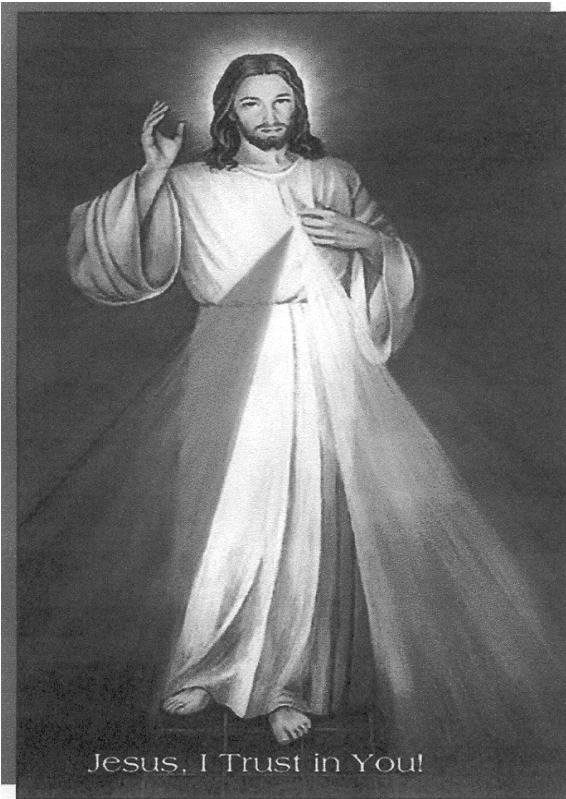
**Children’s Liturgy of the Word

St. Faustina received the request from **Our Lord for the Feast of Divine Mercy** to be celebrated the Sunday following Easter. He said,

“On that day, the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those who should approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment....mankind will not have peace until it turns to the fount of my mercy.” Diary 699

In Diary 1192, St. Faustina said, “When my soul is in anguish, I think only in this way; Jesus is good and full of mercy, and even if the ground were to give way under my feet, I would not cease to trust in Him”

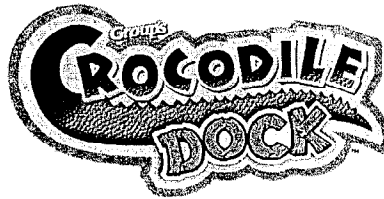

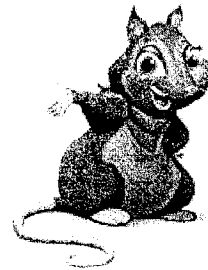
