RESPECT LIFE APOSTOLATE - Education

The RLA offers a number of informational and educational programs aimed at deepening our understanding of the dignity of the unborn, the sanctity of human life and the moral evil of abortion, infanticide, assisted suicide, embryonic stem cell research, cloning and euthanasia. These educational efforts help people understand the importance of witnessing on behalf of all human life in word and in action. To interest people in joining the cause for life, it is necessary to bring these life issues to the forefront. The community must be educated in the affront against all phases of life, how these atrocities lead to the continued denial of human dignity, and what will affect change in the parish and community. The primary purpose of educational programs is the development of attitudes that respect life. Visit the website: www.stlrespectlife.org

Education in all areas about the sanctity of life for all age groups should be a part of the ongoing educational efforts within each parish. **Incarnate Word** participates in the educational program "**Right Start**" Program for 8th grade students. The students also participate in the RLA Creative Writing Contest - four \$1000 scholarships are awarded to the top four students planning to attend a Catholic High School. **High School Students: LIFT** (Life Information From Teens) is a program for high school students who want to get more involved in the pro life movement. **For the Parish - Pro Life Profiles** is published quarterly and is an educational program designed as a parish bulletin insert and includes timely articles on life issues from a Catholic perspective. **General Public - Annual Respect Life Convention** held during October. The purpose of the Convention is to provide a forum for Catholics in the Archdiocese of St. Louis to gather and listen to informative and motivational speakers discuss the dignity and sanctity of human life and the latest efforts to build a Culture of Life. **Young Adults - "Young Friends for Life"** is a new pro life group recently formed by the RLA.
