The Fall semester of school began in late August and she is worried that it won't be as easy to handle as she first thought. At four months along, she is feeling a lot more tired than usual due to the stress of her situation. She is also uncomfortable that she will be showing soon and feels that it will cause her to stand out and be judged. Her attitude toward the baby is still a positive one.

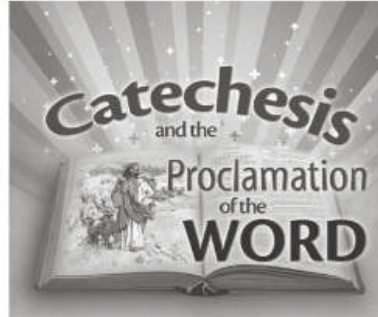

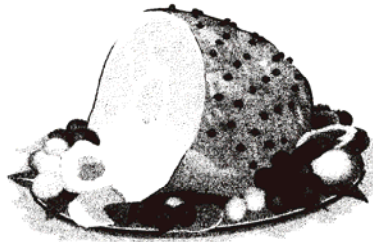
