

# 2010 W Trunk or Treat Guidelines

Once again Incarnate Word's 10<sup>th</sup> annual Halloween Trunk or Treat event is a sell-out! Please review the guidelines below to insure a safe and fun evening for our children.

Remember YOU are responsible for YOUR children ALL EVENING.

- Trunk or Treating will begin shortly after 7:00pm. Please arrive around 6:00pm and park in your assigned spot. The lot will be sealed off to traffic after 6:45pm.
- Overflow parking is in the lower lot. Please do not park in the rectory area as this is for Adoration parking only.
- While cars are pulling into the parking lot and parents are setting up, there will be a Halloween movie playing on a big screen in the Kent Center for ALL children from 6:00pm-7:00pm.
- Parents please walk your children to the Kent Center when you first arrive. All parents must pick up your children from the gym at 7:00pm. No child will be able to leave the gym without a parent.
- We are looking for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders who want to earn service hours to help keep an eye on the kids in the Kent Center. Please contact Patty Rowland at [threerows@hotmail.com](mailto:threerows@hotmail.com) if your child can help.
- After the children are released at 7:00pm, a blow horn will sound shortly after 7:00pm and Trunk or Treating will begin at this point.
- We do not want children of any age wandering around the parking lot until you hear the blow horn.
- Children are not to be anywhere near the field or the lower parking lot at any time during the evening.
- At 8:30pm we will again sound the blow horns. At this time cars may begin leaving. Parents PLEASE make sure your child of any age is not running around after 8:30pm. Many cars are leaving at once and it is hard enough for them to back out of their spots without having to look in every direction for kids out playing.
- Restrooms are available in the Kent Center lobby. The doors to the lobby will be locked at 9:00pm.
- All cars must be off the lot by 10:00pm.
- YOU are responsible for cleaning up the area around you.

Trunk or Treat has grown very popular over the last 9 years and it is our hope to have it continue for many more years to come. Please remember that this event is for the KIDS and these guidelines are for their safety.
